FAR 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors-Commercial Items, applies to this acquisition. Award will be made to the lowest priced, technically acceptable offeror. Provide *as part of their offer. In the event that a vehicle requires replacement (for any reason) during the performance period, the Contractor shall provide a replacement vehicle in good conditions within eight (8) hours of notice by the Contracting Officer Representative or the Contracting Officer.* FAR clause 52.212-4, Contract Terms and Conditions-Commercial items, applies to this acquisition.
