

## LOCAL ADVERTISEMENT/SOLICITATION FOR COMMERCIAL ITEM

The U.S. Embassy in **Panama** has a requirement for **Office Furniture**. Please note that this is a combined synopsis/solicitation for a commercial item, prepared in accordance with the format FAR 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; offers are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation number is **SPM070-10-Q-0023** and is issued as a Request for Quotation. The solicitation/contract will include all applicable provisions and clauses in effect through **FAC 2005-39**. Items to be acquired:

**Requirements:** Seven (7) workstations with L-shape, size (1.80mt x 1.80mt), Four (4) shared workstations with L-shape, size (1.80mt x 1.70mt), One (1) workspace with L-shape, size (2.00mt x 2.20mt), Two (2) Straight workspaces, size (1.60mt x .60cm), Two (2) common areas, size (1.60mt), the common areas shall consist of: (2) cabinets of two levels with doors & locks, (2) Hanging Furniture with doors & key lock.

*Each Workspace shall contain a file cabinet of two (2) drawers with lock, One (1) mobile file cabinet with an auxiliary drawer with lock for filing.*

*Each Workspace with L-shape shall have (2) hanging cabinets with doors & key lock with a measurement of (.60cm & 1.20mt.)*

*Shared Common Areas shall have (2) Hanging cabinets with doors & key lock with following measurements as (.60cm & .80cm). The height of the panels against the walls shall be (1.57mts & .97cm.)*

Deliver F.O.B. destination to **US Embassy Panama Warehouse, Demetrio Basilio Lakas #783, Clayton**, no later than **15 Days** after contract award. FAR 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors-Commercial Items, applies to this acquisition. Award will be made to the lowest priced, technically acceptable offeror. FAR clause 52.212-4, Contract Terms and Conditions-Commercial items, applies to this acquisition. FAR clauses 52.217-8 Option to Extend Services (Nov 1999), 52.217-9 Option to Extend the Term of the Contract (MAR 2000) and 52.232-19, Availability of Funds for the Next Fiscal Year will apply to the resultant contract.
